NEW CITY CATECHISM - QUESTION #11 (The underlined portions correspond to the Children's Catechism studied at home this week by New City families.)

Leader

What does God require in the sixth, seventh and eighth commandments?

Congregation

<u>Sixth, that we do not hurt, or hate</u>, or be hostile to <u>our</u> <u>neighbor</u>, but be patient and peaceful, pursuing even our enemies with love. <u>Seventh, that we</u> abstain from sexual immorality and <u>live purely and faithfully</u>, whether in marriage or in single life, avoiding all impure actions, looks, words, thoughts, or desires, and whatever might lead to them. <u>Eighth, that we do not take without permission that</u> <u>which belongs to someone else</u>, nor withhold any good from someone we might benefit.

SEE ACCOMPANYING INSERT

Luke 16:1-13

He also said to the disciples, "There was a rich man who had a manager, and charges were brought to him that this man was wasting his possessions. ²And he called him and said to him, 'What is this that I hear about you? Turn in the account of your management, for you can no longer be manager.' ³And the manager said to himself, 'What shall I do, since my master is taking the management away from me? I am not strong enough to dig, and I am ashamed to beg. ⁴I have decided what to do, so that when I am removed from management, people may receive me into their houses.' 5 So, summoning his master's debtors one by one, he said to the first, 'How much do you owe my master?' ⁶He said, 'A hundred measures of oil.' He said to him, 'Take your bill, and sit down quickly and write fifty.' 7 Then he said to another, 'And how much do you owe?' He said, 'A hundred measures of wheat.' He said to him, 'Take your bill, and write eighty.' ⁸The master commended the dishonest manager for his shrewdness. For the sons of this world are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation than the sons of light. 9 And I tell you, make friends for yourselves by means of unrighteous wealth, so that when it fails they may receive you into the eternal dwellings.

¹⁰ "One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much, and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much. ¹¹ If then you have not been faithful in the unrighteous wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches? ¹² And if you have not been faithful in that which is another's, who will give you that which is your own? ¹³ No servant can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money."

Jesus desires his people to use kingdom wisdom concerning money and possessions.

Klyne Snodgrass – "The master praised the [the manager] for his quick thinking, his shrewdness or wisdom, to insure his own future. No more is intended than that" (*Stories with Intent*, p. 414).

4. Why the commentary on the parable in verses 8b-9?

5. How is the parable's teaching intended to function in our lives?

Klyne Snodgrass – "Just as [the manager] acted to safeguard his well-being, how much more in this eschatological age should Jesus' hearers act to safeguard their own eternal dwelling" (*Stories with Intent*, p. 416).
